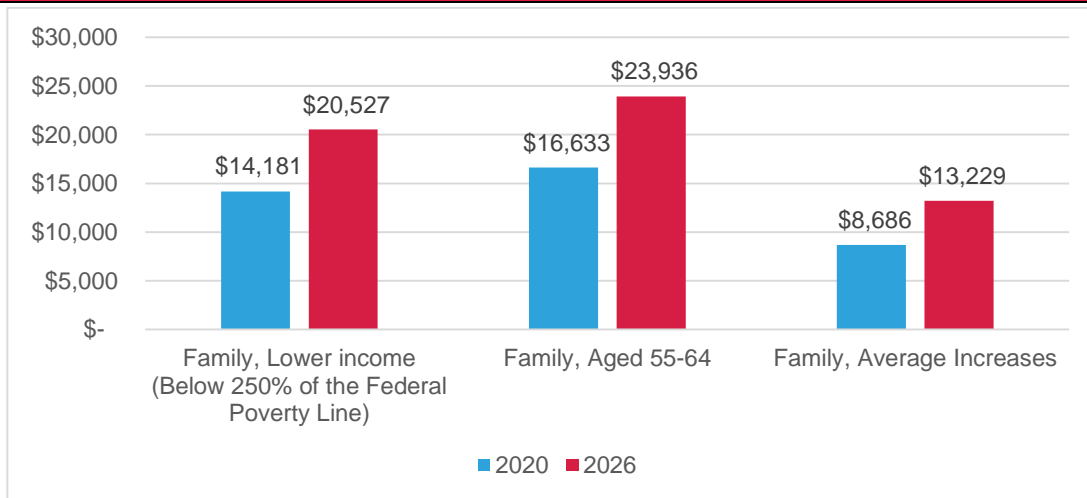

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IMPACT ON STATE BUDGET



BY 2020, THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE ESTIMATES A LOSS OF:
\$100-\$550 MILLION IN FEDERAL MONEY

AFTER 2020, THIS COULD RESULT IN A LOSS OF
\$1 BILLION A YEAR IN FEDERAL MONEY

	NOW (Under the Affordable Care Act)	WHAT COULD CHANGE
COVERAGE ON ACCESS HEALTH CT	Subsidies, or financial help, are currently based on your income, and the cost of health insurance in your local area	Financial help will be based on your age , not how much you can afford, or how much insurance costs, which means a drop in subsidies for most of those who receive them
HUSKY / MEDICAID	States are reimbursed a portion of every dollar spent on children, parents/caregivers, disabled people, elderly (especially those in nursing homes), and the Medicaid expansion (HUSKY D)	Radical restructuring of Medicaid puts limits on the federal share of Medicaid costs, reducing Medicaid funding and forcing states to cover fewer people
INSURANCE THROUGH YOUR EMPLOYER	The ACA requires certain employers to offer insurance to their workers	The new bill gets rid of the requirement for certain employers to provide insurance

PLANNED PARENTHOOD WOULD LOSE FEDERAL FUNDS FOR A YEAR

In Connecticut, Planned Parenthood:

- Is the state's largest provider of reproductive health care and family planning
- Has 17 health centers that serve 60,000 women and men a year
- Is the first and often the only health provider for many young patients
